Professor Itaya (PI) honored with "The Prix Jacques Tacussel Award of the International Society of Electrochemistry".

Professor Itaya, PI of WPI-AIMR, has been selected as the winner of the Prix Jacques Tacussel of the International Society of Electrochemistry (ISE), in recognition of his pioneering development of atomic-resolution in-situ scanning tunneling microscopy (STM) and laser confocal microscope combined with a differential interference contrast microscope (LCM-DIM) for electrochemistry.
